## ABOUT MCH

MCH has provided services to persons with disabilities for over 2 decades. In 1981, a group with a special interest in people with disabilities started a support group in Franklin. From that modest beginning, MCH has grown to be a viable service provider with a strong history of excellent services.

MCH operates 6 group homes for persons with developmental disabilities, a day program, and Alternative Family Living Arrangements as well as community-based services to persons with intellectual and intellectual and developmental disabilities. MCH employs more than 70 professional, administrative, and paraprofessional staff and offers a benefit package with health and ancillary insurance, paid time off, and 401(k) to full-time employees. Programs are nationally accredited. MCH sets a high standard of quality, and staff undergo thorough training.

Six group homes blend into their respective neighborhoods just as do our residents who are good neighbors in the community.

MCH promotes green practices, and MCE has a green card-making business. Cards are made from recycled paper which is also made by the clients from used paper. A greenhouse provides work for individuals served as well as community inclusion.

MCH is a private, non-profit organization governed by a board of directors. MCH does not discriminate on the basis of race, sex, color, religion, national origin, age, or handicap.

## MORE ABOUT SERVICES

MCH has 4 ICF-IID group homes in Macon and Jackson Counties. These group homes serve people with intellectual and developmental disabilities and must offer active treatment, on-going training to promote independence. Each home has 6 beds and is located in a residential area, and is staffed by 24-hour awake staff.

MCH also operates 2 DDA facilities in Franklin. These facilities serve 6 clients and 3 clients respectively who are supported by NC Innovations, a Medicaid waiver, or state funding, as well as domiciliary care through the Department of Social Services. Training to promote independence is provided, and there is 24-hour staffing.

Macon Citizens Enterprises (MCE) is a day program for persons with developmental disabilities and serves both MCH residential clients and community clients. MCE provides prevocational, activities of daily living, recreational, and social training. MCE offers a unique fitness program, with a fully-equipped, supervised fitness center. MCE clients may do paid work or participate in a special retirement program.

MCH can also provide AFL services as well as community-based services through NC Innovations including Day Supports, In-Home Skill Building, Personal Care, and Community Networking.
